To find a translator in that part of the world is not easy, so in the end a sister from Somalia (she can speak French and English) who resides in USA, visited her mother in Limoges. She did quite a good job and we thank the Lord for her. That was a divine appointment.

The harvest in Europe is huge and ready. There is a great need for more Spirit filled preachers. Please pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.

South Africa.

We came home middle of January and were blessed to preach at the opening of the new church building of 153 Ministries in Randfontein, South Africa.

Then we went to Cape Town for the annual Assemblies of God conference, but could only preach in one church when the lock down was announced and the conference had to be cancelled.

We spend most of our time preparing sermons and studies and Ina and myself will soon re-edit the original Kindling Feeding and Spreading the Flame study book and get it ready for a reprint. By the way; this book has now been translated and is available in Afrikaans under the name 'Voed die Vlam'

We are also trying new recipes and the success shows on the scale.
