Looking through my diary we can see that we have added some miles and that we have been busy.

**Since our last newsletter we have ministered in many different places: Krugersdorp, Mondeor, Boksburg, Wyndford, Bethlehem, Gonubie, Queenstown, Elliot, Port Elizabeth, Kimberley and Hartbeespoort. We were very well received by our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ and saw many responding to the Gospel of our Lord.**

**We had the honour to be part of the Multi Ministries outreach team to a weeklong Gospel Campaign in Elliot.**

The Spirit of our Lord moved with power and many wonderful things happened. What touched my heart was when many young people came forward for prayer after the second night's preaching in the Town Hall to repent of sins and asking God to help them to overcome their weaknesses.

We were a team of 5 evangelists and the gospel was preached to about 2000 people at various places and more or less 800 responded. Truly there is a great hunger amongst so many for the Gospel as both the meetings in the town hall were packed out on week days. There is a buzz amongst the young people of Elliot and we pray that it will keep it's momentum.

Please pray for this beautiful little Eastern Cape town.

**Another highlight was when we were part of the South African Association of Evangelist's outreach team to the Karoo.**

A team of 13 evangelists went to this amazing part of our country to preach the Gospel in the following towns: Steytlerville, Aberdeen, Jansenville, Somerset East, Klipplaat, Willowmore and Graaff Reinett from Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> September. Cecil Peasley and myself worked in Graaff- Reinett. Steve Grewer of Karoo Missions did an excellent job in organizing this event. Several thousand people heard the Gospel and approximate 1000 responded to the altar calls. This does not include the many learners in the schools. Thousand of tracts were handed out. It was wonderful to minister in the 'Groot Kerk' in Graaf- Reinette.

Time is just too short. They say everyone has the same 24 hours per day but I sometimes wonder as I feel that I am doing so little for the advancement of His kingdom.

But we must work as best we can for the night is coming when no man can work.
