
**Nepal: 30 Oct – Delhi 16Nov 2009**

The journey to Nepal went well, except that the booking clerk at Singapore airport did not want to book us onto the plane because of a misspelled surname. Lots of explanation had to be done and computer changes had to be made before we received our boarding passes. Nepal is a beautiful country at the foot of the amazing Himalaya Mountain. Before we could land we had to 'wait' for other air traffic and circled over the valley of Kathmandu having a very clear view of mount Everest.



The churches in Nepal meet on Saturdays. It was a great day when the New Life Gospel Church of ps DK Limbu had the graduation ceremony for the 2008 – 2009 group of 17 students who completed their one year training as evangelists. Several of these students have already started with ministry in different parts of Nepal.



On Monday 2 November the new group of 11 students was welcomed onto the campus. I really enjoy to be present when new students arrive and to see how they quickly grow out of their initial uncertainty and shyness into strong disciples of our Lord. Most of these students are coming from East Nepal. They are very keen to learn about the Bible and discipleship. They cannot speak or write English at all, so all the lectures that I presented to them have to be translated. It was indeed a blessing to walk with them for one week and guide them through the first steps of the school.

On Saturday 6 Nov we preached in another packed church in Kathmandu and enjoyed the presence of the Lord with the precious saints. The Gospel of our Lord is indeed a power as it can bring such different people together in unity.



From Kathmandu we had a very tiring trip to Delhi in India. Dr Thomas Varghese who is the pastor of several churches and director of Mission to the Unreached as well as the dean of the Eastern Theological Seminary (of which I am a student) gave us a warm welcome as always. We ministered to the students and presented one class to the Hindu students. This was a wonderful time as the Holy Spirit moved powerfully during the devotional times. Tomorrow we travel by air to Visakhapatnam in Andhra Pradesh to visit one school and to plant three more if the Lord is willing. The next news will come in two to three weeks time from Visakhapatnam in South India.
